## Power Pipeline #2

### God's Infinite Power

#### Salvation in Him

The second pipeline shows man connected to God's infinite power. This person knows that God is wisdom, knowledge, and power, and is a follower of Jesus. This person has hope as a result of this connection with God, but there is a limit to the internal peace and fruitfulness of his faith. God has far more to offer than what this person seeks out and trusts Him to provide. Where is the choke point? It is us! When our small faith is the connecting pipe through which God's power is passed through, it chokes out what God can do in our lives.

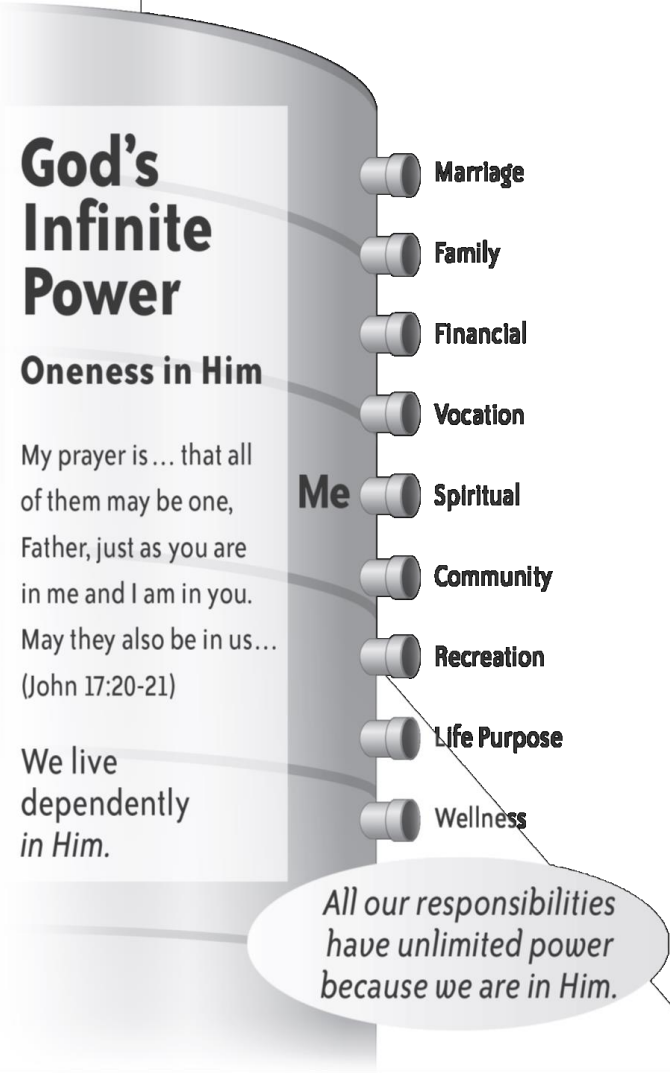
## Power Pipeline #3

### God's Infinite Power

#### Oneness in Him
